The layout artists will be responsible for conceptualizing and producing unique, impactful and appealing layouts, visuals, graphics and video content, in line with GNWP's vision and branding. The ideal candidates would display advanced understanding of graphic design with an emphasis on layout, composition and typography for communications materials, reflected through their use and strong skills in Adobe Suite (including Photoshop, Illustrator, and InDesign) and other multimedia softwares.

**Remuneration:** The artist will be paid a lump sum per project.

### Description:

The Artist will be required to:

- Translate strategic vision into high-quality design within GNWP's established brand identity;
- Use knowledge of graphic design and digital softwares to design and implement multimedia products such as videos, illustrations, images, animations, layouts, templates, and other items;
- Arrange and modify page elements, visuals and graphics for screens and printed media, determining text and image size for each page, to produce cohesive materials;
- Produce materials in several languages, including but not limited to Arabic, English, French, and Spanish (translations will be provided);
- Deliver high-quality content in a timely manner, respecting deadlines which may include several rounds of feedback; and
- Coordinate with the Communications team on upcoming projects and multimedia design needs.

### Qualifications:

- High proficiency in Adobe Creative Suite products such as InDesign, Illustrator, Photoshop, Acrobat, as well as other design softwares;
- Ability to think creatively and make use of innovative concepts to create original and attractive materials and designs;
- Artistic with a keen eye for aesthetics and visually appealing content;
- Excellent attention to detail; and
- Ability to keep deadlines and commitments, as well as work independently and collaboratively.
